- ✦ Author(s) should indicate the facet and topic of the paper distinctly.
- ✦ Pre-declaration by the author(s) should be made separately that the paper has not been sent elsewhere for publication/presentation.
- ✦ The full paper in word file (with an abstract not exceeding 200 words and at least 5 keywords) should be submitted as an e-mail attachment to aludlis2022@gmail.com Paper should not exceed 6 pages (line space: 1.5, font size: 12, font: Times New Roman, reference: APA). Papers will not be accepted without registration fee.
